Who is eligible?	Students in their final year of Bachelor in any field of studies in one of the 12 universities (see list) partner of the Paris-Tech 9+9 program. They should hold a Bachelor degree from one of these universities by September 2015. Candidates should be pre-selected by their home university before applying for the Master in Management – Grande Ecole Program of HEC Paris. Which program can I apply for at HEC Paris?	Candidates within the ParisTech recruitment program may apply for the HEC Master in Management - Grande Ecole Program This program is open to candidates holding a Bachelor in any field and does not require any previous knowledge in management.	
Do I need to speak French to apply for the program?	No, French language is not required to apply for the program but is useful for students who wish to gain knowledge of the French culture and who are interested in doing an internship is France.	
What is the Selection process?	Candidates interested by HEC Master in Management - Grande Ecole Program must undergo a specific admission procedure. Please note that they are exempted from the common ParisTech written exam but must take instead the GMAT or GRE test. IMPORTANT: Candidates can apply for both ParisTech Engineering Schools and the HEC MiM. To apply for the Master in Management – Grande Ecole, candidates must Be pre-selected by their home university Fill out the specific online application between 25th August and 29th September 2014 Upload the following documents: Certificate of enrolment stating that you are in your final year of studies Transcripts including transcripts from exchange programs if applicable, GMAT or GRE test score (no specific preference for HEC but all parts of the test must be passed) Résumé (CV) Passport photo Passport or Identity Card (in English) Two recommendations by professors (these recommendations are exclusively online) This means that you must fill out the information concerning your referee. He/she will receive a specific e-mail inviting them to fill out the reference. You are yourself informed when the reference has been completed. A conditional admission may be offered to candidates, who haven't submitted any test by the end of November. The score must be submitted no later than December 15th 2014. Please Note that these candidates are not eligible to apply for the Eiffel Scholarship • 15th December: Financial confirmation for Eiffel candidates • 5th January 2015: Financial confirmation for all candidates. IMPORTANT: Please note that candidates applying for HEC through the ParisTech are not eligible to apply for HEC through SAI.





Can I apply for another HEC MSc program as a second choice?	No, the ParisTech agreement allows candidates to apply exclusively for the Master in Management – Grande Ecole.	
How long is the duration of the Program?	 The duration of the program is two years: Master 1 (General management courses) Master 2 (Specialization) Gap Year: Every student of the program may take advantage of a Gap Year between the Master 1 and Master 2 in order to gain professional experience by doing one or two internships in France or abroad. 	
What specializations are offered? What are the tuition fees?	Non-EU students: M1: 18,000€ M2: 18,000€ There is no tuition for the Gap Year but an administrative fee of 750€.	
What is the application fee?	Candidates from the ParisTech universities are exempted from the application fee.	





When and how to apply for scholarships?	 Eiffel Scholarship: beginning of January each year. Candidates must have secured their seat financially to apply for this grant by end of December. Please note, that candidates cannot apply individually as applications must be prepared and transmitted to Egide by January by HEC. Only complete applications will be transferred to Egide. The China Scholarship Council in March of each year The French Embassy Excellence Scholarship in spring (students who win the Eiffel Scholarship are not eligible to apply for this grant) The HEC merit based scholarship: Candidates for this scholarship may apply upon admission (This scholarship will be cancelled if the student win the Eiffel Scholarship The Air France Scholarship for admitted students (in September) Contact for more information: hecprograms@hec.fr	IMPORTANT: In order to apply for Eiffel, students must have submitted their GMAT or GRE before the admissions jury beginning of December and must have secured their seat financially
What are the teaching languages?	The teaching languages at HEC Paris are English and French. Students study the mandatory management courses in M1 year in English and students having a good level in French may take electives in French. Non French speaking students are required to study a French language course during the first semester of M1 and may continue the whole year and the second year if the schedule allows it. All students are offered to take the French CEF test at all levels.	
What is the duration of the studies?	2 academic years.	
When does the company internship take place?	To graduate from HEC Master in Management - Grande Ecole, students must validate a minimum of 30 weeks of internship. Students who already have previous management related work/internship experience may apply for partial exemption up to a maximum of 15 weeks. In general students take advantage of the Gap Year to complete the internship requirement but may also work in summer between the Master 1 and Master 2 year and complete the remaining requirement after the Master 2 year.	HEC does not find internships for each student but the close links to the corporate world with prestigious companies and the reputation of the School are useful. The HEC Career services also organizes specific internship/job fairs, coordinates the job intranet, organize specific seminars all over the year and offers personal coaching to students.
What is the Gap-Year? Is it mandatory?	The Gap-Year, a one year break between Master 1 and Master 2, is not mandatory but is an option that most of the students choose. This is a unique opportunity to spend one year in the workplace in order to gain professional experience and extra exposure on your CV. It is also an opportunity to 'test' a particular field of activity, a time to consider changing career and goals and to think about your choice of specialization. Some specializations require a least one internship in the field of the specialization before the start of the program.	





Which degree will I be awarded?	Students admitted to ParisTech programme and who successfully complete the requirements will obtain the HEC Grande Ecole Master Degree.	The Master in Management Grande Ecole is accredited by the French Ministry of Education
What are the requirement to graduate	 Total number of ECTS credits: 120 (M1: 60, M2: 60) Research Paper 30 weeks of internship. 	
Is TCF/TEF score required for Visa application?	No.	
Does HEC Paris provide on campus accommodation?	HEC offers housing possibilities to all international students under the condition that they book the room by the given deadline. Living expenses are approximately 1000€/month housing included (500 − 600€ per month).	
What about social life?	In order to make the best out of the HEC experience, all students studying at HEC are encouraged to join at least one or two student associations.	Over 120 student associations on campus, both sports, cultural and politics.
